THE PRIX PICTET

The Prix Pictet is widely acknowledged as one of the most esteemed prizes in photography. Created in 2008, the award showcases outstanding photography as an artistic medium to invigorate debate on global environmental sustainability. In ten cycles to date, the Prix Pictet has addressed the themes of *Water, Earth, Growth, Power, Consumption, Disorder, Space, Hope, Fire* and *Human*.

To date, more than 5,000 photographers have been nominated, with over 100 exhibitions in 44 cities across 24 countries. The theme for the eleventh cycle, announced in the opening week of Les Recontres d'Arles, is *Storm*.
